The above consolidated financial result is reviewed by other auditors whose report have been furnished to us by the management and our conclusion on the unaudited consolidated Ind AS financial statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of the aforesaid subsidiary, our report in terms of subsection (3) and sub-section (11) of section 143(3) of the act in so far as it relates to the aforesaid subsidiary company is based solely on such report and financial result of the other auditor.

Further, the above subsidiary located outside India whose financial results and other financial information have been prepared accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in their respective countries and which have been reviewed by other auditors under generally accepted auditing standards applicable in their respective countries.
